



Announcement of the Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Industry  
Subject: Refraining from Accepting Any Gifts of All Kinds for the Performance of  
Duties Policy (No Gift Policy) for the Fiscal Year 2024

The Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Industry, places importance and support on operations following the Thai government's policies and the National Reformation Plan on anti-corruption and misconduct by taking part in creating an honest culture and values in working morally, ethically, and transparently, without seeking personal benefits from performing duties while preventing corruption. This is to enhance the image of Thailand.

Therefore, to express the intention and commitment to create an honest culture and values in performing official duties—with legitimacy, transparency, fairness, and a volunteer spirit, prioritizing public interest over personal gain—the Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Industry, hereby announces the policy to ensure that the Office shall be an organization where all authorities—including executives, government officials, employees, and those working under the Office of the Minister of Industry—refrain from accepting any gifts of all kinds, whether it be before, during, or after performing duties that may lead to corruption and misconduct, either now or in the future. Exceptions are made in the case of accepting properties or benefits that comply with laws, rules, or regulations issued by virtue of the provisions of the laws, as well as ethically accepting those that align with criteria and amounts specified by the National Anti-Corruption Commission of Thailand. Furthermore, the authorities shall not seek illegal gifts or benefits and are responsible for making the stated policy widely known to outsiders.
